

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the difference between the HSHS St. Vincent/Bellin Site and the Aurora BayCare Medical Center (ABMC) site?

Both programs

- Are licensed Project SEARCH® programs and utilize the same training curriculum and internship processes.
- Work on industry skills to obtain a job AND soft skills to keep the job!
- Have a goal of competitive integrated community employment.

HSHS interns are individuals in their last year of High School eligibility (ages 18-21). ABMC interns are adults who have already left high school. They may have worked in the community before or are receiving services from pre-vocational programs like Aspiro.

Q: What basic skills are necessary for admittance to the program?

Appropriate hygiene/appearance, social and communication skills, following verbal, visual, and written directions, and the ability to change behavior/accept feedback as demonstrated through skills assessment. Additionally, a strong desire to work demonstrated through daily attendance, positive attitude, and a commitment to seek employment.

Q: What if my individual has already tried community employment?

The goal of Project SEARCH® is to teach hands on work skills AND soft skills. These soft skills include but are not limited to topics such as effective communication, self-advocacy, conflict resolution, time management, independence, and workplace etiquette.

Q: What about transportation to the program?

The intern's care team are responsible for coordinating transportation.

Q: What is the family's involvement?

Guardians are expected to attend review meetings throughout the program, and actively support the intern while job searching. This support includes working with DVR and long-term care services as applicable.

Q: What happens after completion of the program?

Project SEARCH® and Aspiro staff continue to work with the graduate to obtain community employment. Long-term support while on the job is also offered through Aspiro.
