**COVID-19 Update**

On Wednesday, October 28th we were notified that an individual in our Stiles Road Prevocational Services tested positive for COVID-19. Per our protocols, we have asked the person to isolate until they are well. We have completed internal contact tracing per CDC guidelines and notified those who may have been in close contact. If you have not been notified, your loved one/ward was not in close contact with the individual.

ASPIRO's focus will continue to be to prevent symptomatic people from accessing ASPIRO facilities through daily temperature screening, temporarily removing individuals who present symptoms, and welcoming back clients and staff once they have recovered from COVID-19.

ASPIRO follows the best practice of having everyone wear a face mask, encourage hand washing/using hand sanitizer and practice social distancing. Additional cleaning and disinfecting also takes place daily at the Dousman and Stiles locations.

ASPIRO is determined to provide a safe and welcoming place for the people who utilize our services.

As the cases in Brown County continue to escalate we encourage you to closely monitor your health and, if you develop flu or other symptoms including a dry cough and fever, please contact your medical provider and ASPIRO as soon as possible.

Our best wishes go out to the person who has tested positive and we cannot wait to have them rejoin us at ASPIRO.

Definitions:

Close contact is defined by CDC as someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic clients, 2 days prior to positive specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.
