## RICH HISTORY



In 1957, sixty-seven parents of children with disabilities established the Brown County Association for Retarded Children (now ASPIRO) to help inform our community of the needs of people with cognitive disabilities and to provide programs for their children. In 1967, they built and opened the Dousman Street location we still use today.
