

Residential Services



The purpose of **Residential Services** aims to make living in the community a reality. We provide the support needed to allow a person with a disability to live in his or her own residence. We encourage their individual choices, enabling each individual to reach his/her potential with guidance and support from significant others. Staff hours are built around the individual's schedule.

Eligibility: Anyone 18 years of age or older with an intellectual disability.

Daily Living Skills Training

Prior to occupying a residence, ASPIRO offers personalized pre-placement daily living skills training in a mock apartment. Based on ability and future goals, individuals can participate in one-on-one or small group training on meal planning and preparation, shopping, housekeeping, laundry, riding the bus, health and safety.

Placement Process

Interested individuals will go through a placement process. We will work with you to make this transition a success!

- Secure funding. ASPIRO accepts public or private assistance.
- Complete an assessment. Complete Daily Living Skills Training if needed (see description to the left).
- Staff recruitment. We encourage the participation of families and/or guardians in the hiring process.
- Locate a residence.
- Receive on-going support from residential staff.
- Continually evaluate progress.
